

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY – INTER LIBRARY LOANS

I wish to make application to The Orkney Library & Archive to acquire items via their Inter Library Loan service and I agree to their terms and conditions as detailed below:

I will provide my name and contact details (address, telephone number & email).

I will pay a mandatory charge per request as set by The Orkney Library & Archive. (The cost of acquiring a British Standard would be the full cost of a request as set by The British Library. The cost of acquiring a PhD Thesis can vary according to the supplier).

I will not exceed more than 10 requests within a 3 month period.

I will agree to pay any onward postage costs if I am unable to collect my request from the library within a reasonable time after being notified of its arrival.

I will observe the loan period and return it within the stipulated term (the loan period is set by the lending library) and if I require it for longer than the loan period I will apply for an extension of loan via The Orkney Library & Archive and meet any costs incurred.

If I fail to collect the item that I have requested for any reason I will pay the full cost of the request (as set by the lending library) together with the cost of the return postage.

I understand that if I cancel a request I may be liable for the full costs incurred.

PLEASE NOTE: If a book is still in print and costs under £12.00 to purchase, or if it has been published within the last six months, we cannot use this service to acquire it for you.
